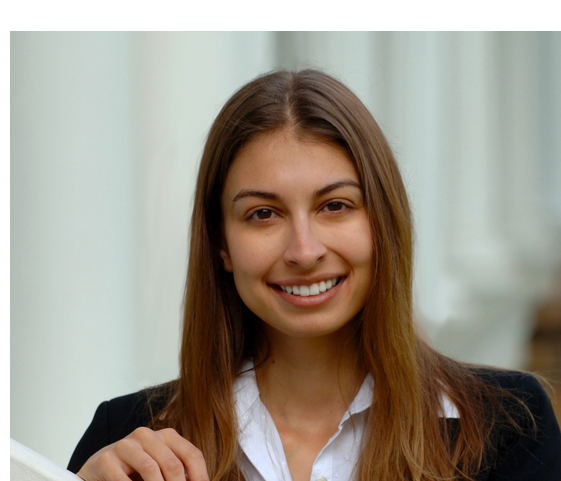

Faculty Profile: Kelli Alces Williams

[Kelli Alces Williams](#), the FSU College of Law Matthews & Hawkins Professor of Property, is an expert on corporate governance, fiduciary duties and securities regulation. She is currently working on an article about consumer disclosure regulations. Professor Williams teaches Contracts, Corporations, Securities Regulation and Bankruptcy. Prior to joining the Florida State University College of Law faculty in 2007, Professor Williams taught at the University of Richmond School of Law as a visiting professor. She has also been a visiting professor at the University of Iowa College of Law, the George Mason University School of Law and the University of Chicago Law School. Before entering academia, she was an associate at the Chicago law firm of Gardner, Carton & Douglas. Williams holds a B.A. in government from the College of William and Mary and a J.D. from the University of Illinois College of Law.

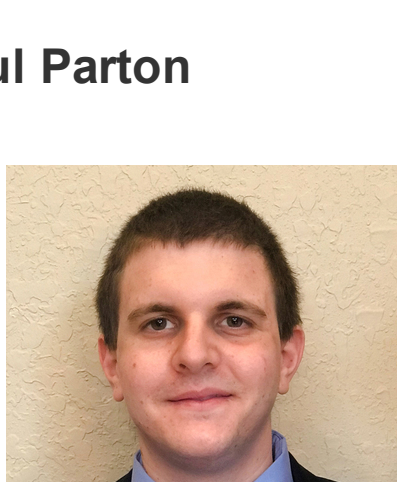


Student Profile: 2018 Grad Paul Parton

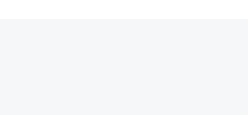
