OBJECTIVES AND METHODS

ATTORNEY GENERAL EXTERNSHIP

ANTITRUST SECTION

OBJECTIVE I Develop pre-trial practice skills.

- METHOD
1. Develop initial skills in case planning and negotiation:
 - a. Participate in discussions and planning regarding case strategy with supervising attorney.
 - b. Attend and participate in discussions with opposing counsel regarding discovery, settlement, or other pre-trial issues.
 2. Draft, under supervision, documents such as:
 - a. Briefs.
 - b. Legal memoranda.
 - c. Motions and responses to motions.

OBJECTIVE II Develop discovery skills.

- METHOD
1. Draft investigative subpoenas such as:
 - a. Interrogatory Civil Investigative Demands.
 - b. Oral Civil Investigative Demands.
 - c. Documentary and Duces Tecum Civil Investigative Demands.
 - d. Motions to Compel Production.
 - e. Responses to Petitions relating to the above.

2. Draft or conduct, under supervision, discovery such as:
 - a. Interrogatories.
 - b. Depositions or Oral Statements.
 - c. Document Productions.
 - d. Requests for Admissions.
 - e. Motions to Compel Production
 - f. Responses to various discovery requests and motions.

OBJECTIVE III Gain familiarity and initial competency in hearing/pre-trial skills.

- METHOD
1. Observe and later participate, if feasible, in pre-hearing/pre-trial activities such as:
 - a. Witness interviews.
 - b. Anticipation of possible evidentiary problems and preparation of responses.
 - c. Motion hearings.

OBJECTIVE IV Develop an academic familiarity with substantive areas of law.

- METHOD
1. Review statutes, regulations and cases applicable.
 2. Review applicable substantive areas with supervising attorney.

OBJECTIVE V Maintain awareness of progress in the externship program.

- METHOD
1. Make daily entries in daily learning journals.
 2. Send journals to faculty supervisor weekly and discuss progress with supervising attorneys.
 3. Write final report analyzing externship.
