

OBJECTIVES AND METHODS

ATTORNEY GENERAL EXTERNSHIP

ECONOMIC CRIMES LITIGATION UNIT

OBJECTIVE I Obtain an academic familiarity with substantive areas of law.

- METHOD
1. Review and research statutes, regulations and applicable cases with supervising attorney.
 2. Draft research memoranda.

OBJECTIVE II Develop necessary skills in case development.

- METHOD
1. Handle consumer calls under supervision. (Perhaps three or four during a semester.) Determine merit, intervene with merchant.
 2. Learn to review advertisements and consumer offers.
 3. Interview consumers in investigations already opened.
 4. Review documents produced by investigative targets.
 5. Assist with preparations for and attend negotiation sessions with target companies.

OBJECTIVE III Develop necessary skills for litigation.

- METHOD
1. Draft, under supervision, pleadings and discovery as needed for pending litigation.
 2. Prepare for, attend and assist at scheduled hearings for pending litigation.

OBJECTIVE IV Maintain awareness of progress in externship program.

- METHOD
1. Regularly discuss progress with supervising attorneys and faculty supervisor.
 2. Complete final paper analyzing externship.
