

BAR PREP COURSES

A variety of commercial bar review courses are available. You should carefully investigate the course's claims and costs before enrolling. The following is a sampling of commercial bar review courses. *Note: This list is provided as a convenience and does not constitute an endorsement of any kind by The Florida State University College of Law.*

1. **Adaptibar:** The only bar review program with the combination of licensed MBE questions and a unique online tool that analyses your performance and adapts to your strengths and weaknesses on the fly with automatic adjustment of the questions based on your performance, timing analysis, licensed questions, benchmarking your performance with that of your peers, and more.
2. **Bar/Bri:** BAR/BRI offers complete and comprehensive programs for every state's bar exam consisting of written materials, lectures and workshops for the MPRE, Multistate, and state multiple-choice and essay portions of the bar exam. Classes are offered for all 50 state bar exams. Home study options are also available.
3. **Beat The Bar.com:** Study tools designed to be used with MBE questions provided by another bar review provider.
4. **Celebration Bar Review:** Company advertisements state over 90% of its students passed the Florida Bar. Primarily two pricing options. Appears to provide high level of personal attention.
5. **Kaplan PMBR:** Kaplan PMBR provides full-service Complete Bar Review for the Florida, New York, and New Jersey Bar Exams, as well as Multistate courses nationwide. Complete Bar Review features unlimited essay grading, over 2,000 MBE online practice questions, and the option of online classes.
6. **Micromash Bar Review:** Offers its program on floppy disk or CD. Company claims the software adapts to the test-taker in order to pinpoint ever-changing strengths and weaknesses.
7. **MPRE Practice Exam:** The National Conference of Bar Examiners has released an online Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) practice examination called the MPRE Online Practice Exam I. It consists of 60 items and is therefore the same length as an actual MPRE. Each online practice exam is priced at \$24.00 for a one-year subscription that allows unlimited use of the online product by the candidate.
8. **MyBarPrep:** MyBarPrep is an online bar review course with practice questions, online flashcards, outlines, and free career advice to members. Members also receive questions and study materials emailed to them every 48 hours.
9. **Practicing Law Institute:** Offers only a Multi-state Bar Review program via CD-ROM or on the internet.
10. **Reed's Bar Review:** Offers practice MBEs online with available feedback. Seminars, videos, audio courses, flashcards and private tutoring are available. Number of different products.
11. **Supreme Bar Review:** Free MPRE Prep, which offers a comprehensive review for the Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam (MPRE), including a complete lecture via streaming video.
12. **The Study Group:** Offers some personalized assistance to customers. Materials are concentrated lectures primarily available on tape or CD. Also offered are outlines for each subject.
13. **Themis:** Founded by a group of former BAR/BRI leaders, Themis is the first completely online company founded on eLearning principles, which consists of on-demand video lectures broken down into 15-25 minute chapters. Each student is assigned a Personal Bar Exam Adviser, who is a licensed FL attorney and bar exam expert, and provides personalized feedback on essay assignments, answers substantive questions, and offers practical solutions to common mistakes on the bar exam.
