**WOMEN'S LAW SYMPOSIUM SILENT AUCTION TO BENEFIT
REFUGE HOUSE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC**

All proceeds from the event will benefit the Refuge House, an organization that provides direct services to battered women, their children and sexual assault survivors.
