Documentation Réfugiés was founded by the French Section of Amnesty International, Service Oecumenique d'Entraide (CIMADE), Croix-rouge français, Terre d'Asile, the French Ligue des droits de l'homme (LDH), and the Service social d'aide aux emigrants (SSAE) in December 1986 to fill the growing need for extensive, detailed and easily accessible information in French on refugees and the right to asylum. Its objectives were to collect existing information and documentation, to conduct studies and research, and to disseminate the results of this work to member organizations and other interested parties. The Centre was closed down at the end of 1994.
