

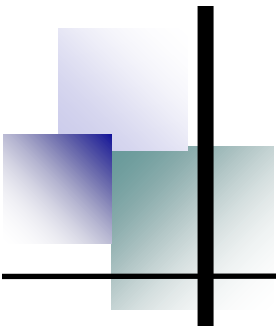
I Don't Know What Kind of Law I Want to Practice
