



What is JSTOR?

JSTOR is a digital collection of core scholarly journals in a wide variety of disciplines including law journals such as Law & Social Inquiry, Law & Society Review, Law and Contemporary Problems, Law and History Review, Law and Human Behavior, Law and Literature, Law and Philosophy, Legislative Studies Quarterly, etc.

- Full-text articles of older journals starting with the first issue, many of which date from the 1800's, are available for searching and printing.
- Since the intention of this database is to provide an archive of journal backfiles, recent issues of journals (last 2 to 5 years) may not be included.

How do I access JSTOR?

JSTOR can be accessed from the Law Library's homepage <http://www.law.fsu.edu/library>. Select **JSTOR** from the '**Most Used Legal Databases**' menus in '**Research Resources**'.

How do I search JSTOR?

JSTOR allows two methods of accessing articles: **Search** and **Browse**.

- Use the Search feature for locating articles by keywords. Search using either the **Basic**, **Advanced**, or **Article Locator** search screens.
- Use Browse feature for locating journal issues and articles by journal name. Browsing can be useful if you would like to skim other articles surrounding a particular article or journal issue.

Basic Search

At the JSTOR start page, select Search. You are ready to search the Basic Search screen.

- Enter search term(s) or phrase in the dialog box.
- You can limit by discipline or leave the default "All Disciplines" selected.
- Click Search button.

Note) Links to Recent Content

JSTOR is able to display citations and links to some recently published articles. If you would like to include recent publications in your search, check the box under the search term box on the Basic or Advanced Search page. In addition to full-text issues available in the archive, you may search and browse by title, author, and abstract of more recent content for select titles.

Advanced Search

- At the *JSTOR* start page, select **Search**.
- Click “**Advanced Search**” link.
- Enter search terms in one of the search boxes.
- Narrow your search by selecting a field, article type, or date range.
- Further limit your search by selecting a discipline or specific journal. To select specific journal, click the box and open the list of journals under that subject area.

Search Tips

To search for an exact phrase	Use Quotation Marks(" "). For example, "punctuated equilibrium"
To search for an article title	Use ti:. For example, ti:"two-person cooperative games"
To search for an author	Use au:. For example, au:"john nash"
to combine terms	Use AND, OR, NOT. For example, ti:"two person cooperative games" AND au:"john nash"
To do wild card searches	Use a question mark (?) for one character or an asterisk (*) for multiple characters. For example, te?ts will find the words tents, tests, and texts. A search on bird* will find bird, birding, birdman, and birds.
To do stem searching	Use a number sign (#) after the word. For example, goose# will find the words goose, geese, and gosling.
To boost term relevance in search results	Increase the importance of any term in your search by using the caret (^) symbol followed by a number that represents "the rise in relevance." For example, the search cat^7 dog gives an occurrence of the word cat in an article seven times more weight than the word dog.
To find words near each other (proximity operators)	Use the tilde (~) symbol with a numeral. For example, if you want to search for the terms debt and forgiveness and want only results with those words within ten words of each other, you would construct the following query: "debt forgiveness"~10.
To find words with similar spellings (fuzzy searching)	Use the tilde(~) symbol after the word. For example, the query ti:dostoyevsky~ will help to locate articles with dostoyevsky in the title, as well as variants like dostoevsky, dostoiievski, dostoevski, dostoyevskii, dostoevski, etc.

Article Locator Search

Use the Article Locator function to quickly search by author, title, journal title, volume, date or ISSN.

- Fill in the fields you know - be sure to check your spelling.
- Leave unknown fields empty - you can search with blank fields.
- Select the "Search" button
- AND, OR, NOT, and field abbreviations do not work in the **Article Locator** search form.

- Use the **Browse** search function to identify articles by looking through journals and issues.
- At the **JSTOR** start page, select **Browse**.
- Select browsing by Discipline, Title, and Publisher
