The Wayback Machine browses through 40 billion archived web pages. You can frequently find old web pages and resources including documents that are no longer available on the Web.

The Wayback Machine can be used to get information that is no longer available on the web. The example to the right is from the Supreme Court Case *Spector v. Norwegian Cruise Line*. This case sites an online report, but that report is no longer available at that URL.

The ADA Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG) Review Advisory Committee--the Government body Congress has charged with formulating the Title III barrier-removal guidelines--has promulgated rules requiring at least one accessible means of egress to be an elevator, whereas SOLAS, which requires at least two means of escape, does not allow elevators to be one of them. You will get the Access Board page as it existed on that date in early 2001 and the document looked for is the third on the list.
