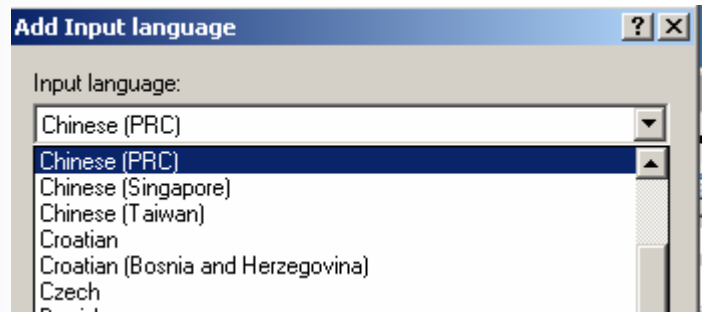
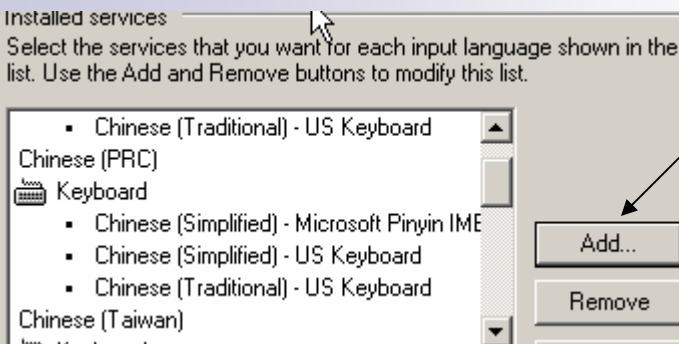
To add Chinese fonts to MS Word, go to Start, click on Control Panel and choose Regional and Language Options.



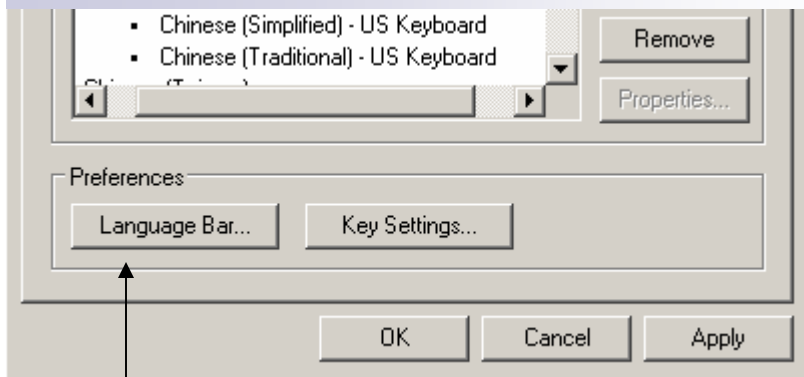
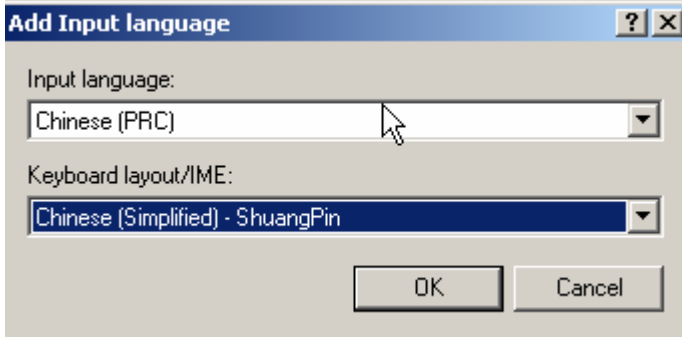
Choose languages and then click Details.



Click Add, then choose Input language. There are many choices and each one works differently. I recommend Chinese PRC.



Choose Keyboard Layout/IME and again there are many choices, but I recommend Microsoft Pinyin IME.



Make sure the language bar is active and you should get something in Word that looks like this.
