

What is HeinOnline?

HeinOnline is a legal database providing access to full-text legal resources. The types of materials covered in HeinOnline include:

- Law reviews
- Federal Register volumes
- Treaties and other international agreements
- Opinions of the U.S. Attorney General
- Cases from the United States Supreme Court

This digital collection offers access to back issues of the earliest legal materials, in some cases dating back to the mid 1800's, from the inception of a publication source to the last three years in original page formatting. New materials are continually added to extend the coverage periods of each journal.

How do I access HeinOnline?

From the Law Library's homepage <http://www.law.fsu.edu/library>, select **HeinOnline** from the **Most Used eResources** menu in the middle of the page. Select **Subscribers**. Choose desired collection.

Searching Law Reviews

Select **Law Journal Library** from Welcome page. You are now in the Browsing mode.

What searching methods are available?

Several searching options are available to users.

1. **Browse** the alphabetical list of journal titles and their coverage.
2. Use the **Citation Navigator** to locate articles quickly. Enter the volume and page and select the journal title from the drop-down menu. Click **Go**.
3. To search for journal articles by author, title, or keyword, click the **Search** button at the top menu.

Searching by Author/Title

1. At the start page, select **Search** from the Navigation Toolbar at the top of the page.
2. Enter author name and/or keywords of a title in the dialog box.
3. Select the field from the drop-down menu field box (title or author).
4. Select AND or OR to limit your search.
5. Select **all titles** to search all journals. You may also select one or more specific journals from the menu.
6. Click **Search Articles**.

Searching full text articles

1. Enter search words in the text box.
2. Check the radio button for type of word search you wish: match any words, all words, or phrase.
3. Select a date range.
4. Select **all titles** if you want all journals searched or specify one or more titles from drop-down list.
5. Select the order of final search results.
6. Click Search.

Full Text Word and Phrase Search

1. Enter your search words here:

- Searches are **not** case-sensitive. [Extended Search Help](#)

2. Match: any words, all words, phrase.

3. Limit results to date range:

- Enter four digit year; leave blank for "since inception" or "through most recent holding".

Year since: Year through:

4. Select journal title(s) to search.

- Hold down the "Ctrl" key when clicking to select multiple titles on most browsers. Limit the number of titles selected for best performance.

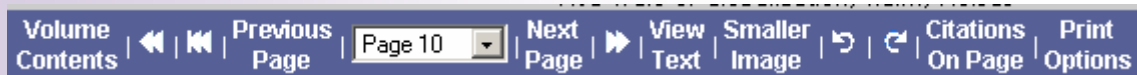

Navigation Tips

The Volume Navigation Toolbar is shown both above and below the article you are viewing and offers several options for moving within that volume.



- The **Volume Contents** button takes you to the Table of Contents for the volume you are currently viewing.
- The first double left arrow takes you back one section or article.
- The second double left arrow takes you to the first page of the article.
- Use the page number pull-down menu to go directly to a specific page within the volume.
- The double right arrow takes you to the next section or article.
- The **View Text** or **View Image** toggle buttons allow you to view the article in its original image or to just view the OCR text of the page. Viewing articles in OCR text allows viewers to search full-text within a volume and to cut and paste portions of articles into word processing programs.
- The **Smaller Image** or **Larger Image** toggle button allows users to change the size of the text.
- The rotating arrows allow users to rotate the image to the right or left.
- The **Citations On Page** button opens up a new window with a list of references found on that page.
- The **Print Options** button opens up a new window offering several printing options.

Searching the Federal Register

Select **Federal Register Library** from Welcome page. Select **Federal Register** again. You are now in the Browsing mode.

What searching methods are available?

Several searching options are available to users.

1. **Browse** the numerical list of Federal Register volumes and their coverage. By selecting a volume, you will then be taken to a list of numbered issues for that volume and the corresponding dates and pages.
2. To **locate a specific item using a Federal Register citation**, use the Citation Navigator at the top of the page. Enter the year and Federal Register page number, and click **Go**. Or, enter the date and click **Go**.
3. To conduct a **full-text word and phrase search**,
 - Enter search words in the text box.
 - Check the radio button for type of word search you wish: match any words, all words, or phrase.
 - Select a date range.
 - Select **all titles** for all Federal Register options or specify one or more titles from drop-down list.
 - Click **Search Text**.

Printing Options

From the HeinOnline Print/Download Options page, two options are given: print in either **Hprint** format or **PDF** format. Since Hprint requires users to first download the printing helper application, it is recommended that you print in **PDF** format. Select either the "Current Section" or "Current Page" of your article. "Current Section" will include entire article. The article or page will open up in another window. Select **Print** button or icon from the Acrobat Reader toolbar.
