




I have read with interest in Action Line, The Florida Bar Real Property and Probate Trust Law section publication relative to disbursement of uncollected funds out of an Attorney's Trust Account.

I urge the immediate approval of the suggested new Court Order. It has been more than a question of inconvenience to The Bar not being able to use this type of check at closing, but it has been a disaster. As a matter-of-fact, in many closings the funds could not be disbursed from closing A to close closing B where the general public could not understand why an attorney could not honor, for example, and basically, Cashier's Checks delivered at closing.

Not only do I urge the approval of the Final Order, but urge it quickly for the benefit of all concerned, The Bar and the general public.

I feel confident that every Attorney writing checks from his Trust Account under the circumstances set forth in the Order understands his or her personal liability and will undertake same carefully and prudently.
