1. This matter is within the exclusive jurisdiction of the
Supreme Court of Florida under Article V, Section 15, Florida
Constitution (1968), and Florida Bar Integration Rule, article XXI.

2. Florida Bar Integration Rule, article XXI, provides that
the Board of Governors may establish a Certification Plan, and
provides further that any future amendments be approved by the
Court.

recommends this Court approve changes to Florida Bar Integration
