PER CURIAM.

We have jurisdiction to review Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida, Inc. v. City of Miami, et al., 486 So.2d 58 (Fla. 3d DCA 1986), under article V, section 3(b)(3), Florida Constitution. This cause presents the same issues of law and fact as Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida, Inc. v. Matthews, No. 67,598 (Fla. Oct. 16, 1986). We quash and remand to allow petitioner to replead its cause of action in light of Matthews.
